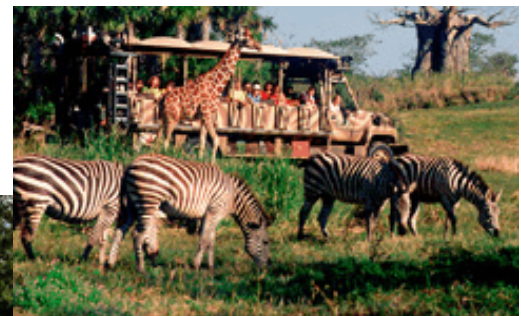
MONDAY, JANUARY 24 - Come join us as we travel to Florida to take in some Disney magic. Our motorcoach will transport us from East Bay locations to San Francisco International Airport where we will board our flight to Orlando. Upon arrival in Orlando we will be transported to Disney's Port Orleans Resort – French Quarter for a six night stay. This resort is inspired by the romance and pageantry of the historic French Quarter in New Orleans, and where every day is a celebration. Step through a wrought-iron portal into an alluring world of delicious Cajun food, jazz music and dazzling parades.

TUESDAY - SATURDAY, JANUARY 25 - 29 - Enjoy Disney World at your leisure. You will have a Five Day Park Hopper that will be your passport to all four of the Disney Parks and unlimited Disney Resort bus transportation. **The Magic Kingdom** theme park captures the enchantment of fairy tales with exciting entertainment, classic attractions, backstage tours and beloved Disney Characters. Travel through the lands and see how fantasy becomes reality when you learn how to be a pirate, match wits with funny monsters and conquer mountains. Get swept up in the spectacle of splendid parades and fireworks shows at Magic Kingdom theme park—it's here that dreams come true for children of all ages. SUNDAY, JANUARY 30 - Today the Disney adventure of our trip comes to an end as we board our motorcoach and travel to Fort Lauderdale to board the Ruby Princess for a seven night relaxing cruise of the Eastern Caribbean. While on board this beautiful ship all of your meals are included, as well as the standard tips for you dinning staff and cabin attendant. The Ruby Princess includes a dramatic piazza-style atrium featuring small-bite eateries and performing street entertainers.
