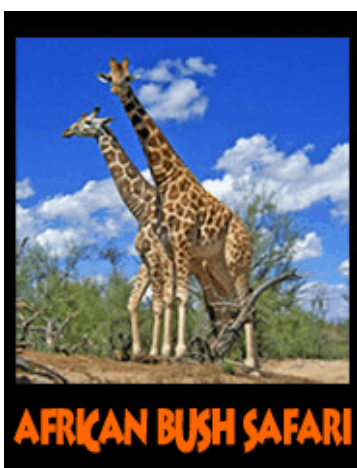

We will enjoy a hosted lunch before we explore the Botanical Gardens. The **Desert Botanical Garden** in Papago Park is not only a botanical garden, but it is also classified as a museum. Desert Botanical Garden covers about 50 acres, and in addition to the vast array of native plants on display, the garden is home to over 21,000 plants representing 3,931 plant classifications in 139 plant families.

**FRIDAY, DECEMBER 31** - We will have a hosted breakfast at our hotel before we depart for the Heard Museum. The **Heard Museum** is unique not only in the exhibits that are displayed, but the style and grace with which it displays its more than 32,000 pieces of cultural and fine art. There are permanent exhibits, like the famous Barry Goldwater collection of Kachina Dolls, as well as special exhibits year-round. Tonight we ring in the New Year at the **Kokopelli Winery**. We will enjoy a five course Winemakers dinner with course wine pairings and a champagne toast. Live music will be played throughout the evening.

**SATURDAY, JANUARY 1 - HAPPY NEW YEAR!!!** Sleep in, then enjoy a hosted breakfast before we depart for some adventure aboard a **Desert Storm Hummer**. We'll experience the scenic wonder of awesome desert as our seasoned guide four wheels us into the majestic Sonoran Desert explaining everything about the wildlife, plantlife, history, geology while showing what "The Hummer" can do.
