Tuesday, February 16 - Join us for a relaxing getaway as spring blooms in the Central Valley. The tour includes lunch and a show at the **Reedley's Opera House**. Situated among mature Oaks and Sycamores, **Wonder Valley Ranch** is our home for the next three evenings. A scrumptious dinner and evening entertainment are included at the Ranch.

Wednesday, February 17 - Today, after an included breakfast at the Ranch, we explore the "Taste of the Valley Tour." Orchards in the Central Valley become a sea of pinks and white when the fruit and nut trees blossom - truly a refreshing view which we hope to see if Mother Nature is willing to cooperate. We will take a wagon ride tour of the **Pizza Farm** where we'll find all of the ingredients to make a farm-fresh pizza growing in pizza-shaped plots. We will then travel through the heart of California's richest agricultural land to Sun Empire Foods and watch the fascinating process of candy making and sample many sweet delights. This side trip includes lunch and concludes with a tasting tour of the **Sequoia View Winery**. Home again to **Wonder Valley Ranch** for an included dinner and this evening's entertainment.

Thursday, February 18 - After our hosted breakfast this morning we will travel to **Millerton Lake** to see one of the largest population of wintering bald eagles. Watch these majestic birds soar from our covered barge as you sip coffee or hot chocolate. We will have a hosted picnic lunch and visit the Historic Millerton Courthouse built in the 1860's. This afternoon we will visit the **Table Mountain Casino** to try your hand at Lady Luck. We will be back at the Wonder Valley Ranch this evening for a hosted dinner and entertainment.

Friday, February 19 - Breakfast is included this morning before we participate in the fun and excitement of the famous **PJ Races**. Have your cameras at the ready for hilarious "once in a lifetime" photos of the antics. Today we travel to the **Hilmar Cheese Factory** for a guided tour. Lunch is included with time scheduled to browse in the shop. This afternoon taste a distinctive variety of flavored olive oils at **Nick Sciabica & Sons**, a traditional family operation and the oldest olive oil producers in California. Approximate arrival time to the Bay Area is 5:00 p.m.
