SUNDAY, MAY 23 - Come join us as we travel to Sparks, Nevada. Our accommodations for the next two nights will be at John Ascuaga's Nugget. Each of us will receive \$5.00 cash and a \$3.00 food coupon. This afternoon we will see the Broadway performance of Cabaret in the Nugget's Celebrity Showroom. Set in 1931 Berlin on the eve of the Nazis' rise to power, it focuses on nightlife at the seedy Kit Kat Klub and revolves around the 19-year-old English cabaret performer Sally Bowles and her relationship with young American writer Cliff Bradshaw. A sub-plot involves the doomed romance between German boarding house owner Fräulein Schneider and her elderly suitor Herr Schultz, a Jewish fruit vendor. Overseeing the action is the Emcee, who presides as master of ceremonies at the Kit Kat Klub and serves as a constant metaphor for the current state of society in Weimar Germany throughout the show.

MONDAY, MAY 24 - Today we will visit the Silver Legacy, downtown Reno, where each of us will receive \$10.00 cash and \$5.00 food. The Silver Legacy is connected to the Circus Circus and the Eldorado, so you can walk between the three properties without going outside. This evening is free.

TUESDAY, MAY 25 - Today we will travel back to California via Lake Tahoe stopping at the Red Hawk Casino where each of us will receive \$10.00 cash. Approximate arrival time back to the Bay Area is 6:00 pm.
