- <u>MONDAY, JUNE 7</u> Come join us as we travel to Northern California. Our first stop will be at the Sierra Nevada Brewery for a guided tour followed by a hosted lunch. This afternoon we will visit the National YoYo Museum. The National Yo-Yo Museum features the worlds largest public display of yo-yo, yo-yo memorabilia, and contest awards. Our accommodations for the next four nights will be at the Holiday Inn Express in Redding.
- <u>TUESDAY, JUNE 8</u> Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel before we board our motorcoach for a guided tour of the beautiful Mt. Shasta area. Mount Shasta is a potentially active volcano at the southern end of the Cascade Range. At an elevation of 14,179 feet, it is the second-highest peak in the Cascades and the fifth-highest in the state. Hosted lunch at the Black Bear Diner. We will have time to browse in the shops in Mt. Shasta City and visit the Mt. Shasta Fish Hatchery.
- WEDNESDAY, JUNE 9 We have a hosted breakfast at our hotel before we have a guided tour of the Wild Horse Sanctuary. Rather than allow 80 wild horses living on public land to be destroyed, the founders of the Wild Horse Sanctuary made a major life decision right then and there to rescue these unwanted horses and create a safe home for them. Our hosted lunch will be at Lumberjack's. This afternoon we will visit the Turtle Bay Exploration Park, on the Sacramento River, which tells the story of the region and its people through wildlife exhibits, gardens, and trails, the spectacular enclosed Butterfly House, and the Turtle Bay Museum.
- <u>THURSDAY, JUNE 10</u> Hosted breakfast at our hotel before we explore Mt. Lassen National Park with our step-on guide. Lassen Volcanic National Park is home to steaming fumaroles, meadows freckled with wildflowers, clear mountain lakes, and numerous volcanoes. Jagged peaks tell the story of its eruptive past while hot water continues to shape the land. We will have a hosted picnic lunch along the way. Tonight we will have a hosted dinner at CR Gibbs.
- FRIDAY, JUNE 11 Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel before we depart for Sacramento. We will have a hosted lunch at the Firehouse Restaurant in Old Town. There will be time to explore the many interesting and unique shops and maybe even take in the California Railroad Museum. Approximate arrival time back will be 6:00 p.m.
