THURSDAY, APRIL 22 - Come join us as we travel north to The Evergreen State, **Washington**. Our first stop will be at the **Lumberjack's** for a hosted lunch. Our accommodations for the night will be at **Seven Feathers Hotel Casino** in Canyonville, Oregon. You will receive a \$5.00 Food coupon.

FRIDAY, APRIL 23 - Today we continue north stopping at **Salty's**, overlooking the Columbia River, for a hosted lunch. Our accommodations for the next four nights will be at the **Embassy Suites** in Lynnwood. We have a hosted Manager's Reception at our hotel each evening.

SATURDAY, APRIL 24 - Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning. Our journey to **Tillicum Village** begins as we board our boat for a relaxing cruise to Blake Island Marine State Park. When we arrive we will savor clam appetizers in a lightly seasoned nectar broth. Then enter the great cedar longhouse for an award-winning salmon feast. As we finish our meal, the lights dim while the myth and magic come to life in a spellbinding show of traditional dances, myths and legends of the Northwest Coast. After the show, take a stroll on their pristine beaches and forested trails or browse through their unique gift gallery full of NW Coast Native American handcrafted treasures. Hosted Manager's Reception at our hotel this evening.

SUNDAY, APRIL 25 - Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning. Our first stop today will be at the **Ballard Locks and Fish Ladder**. Built in 1917, the Ballard Locks link Puget Sound with Lake Washington and Lake Union. The ladder has 21 steps and allows for several prominent species of fish, including salmon and steelhead—to spawn upriver. You will have time to browse in the shops and have lunch on your own at **Pikes Market**. The Market opened August 17, 1907, and is one of the oldest continually operated public farmers' markets in the United States. It is a place of business for many small farmers, craftspeople and merchants. This afternoon we will visit the Museum of Flight. **The Museum of Flight** is the largest independent, non-profit air and space museum in the world. Hosted dinner this evening at the **Seattle Space Needle**.

MONDAY, APRIL 26 - We will start our day with a hosted breakfast before traveling to the **Skagit Valley Tulip Festival**.

*This festival celebrates the beauty of the fields filled with blooming tulips of all colors and varieties. The growers at RoozenGaarde and Tulip Town offer display gardens worthy of that special photo and those unique souvenirs to commemorate your visit. Manager's Reception at our hotel before we go to **Lombardi's** for a hosted dinner.*

TUESDAY, APRIL 27 - Enjoy a hosted breakfast this morning before we depart. Enjoy a hosted lunch at the **Crackerbarrel** in Portland. This afternoon we will visit the **End of the Oregon Trail Interpretive Center**, where we will learn about the history of the Oregon Trail and the pioneer families. Our accommodations for the next three nights will be at the **Oregon Garden Resort** in Silverton.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 28 - After a hosted breakfast at our hotel we depart for the **Willamette Pie Company** for a slice of pie and shopping. Today you will have time to explore the **Oregon Gardens** on your own. This evening we will go to **310 Water** for a hosted dinner.

THURSDAY, APRIL 29 - After a hosted breakfast at our hotel we will travel to **Pacific Hazelnut & Candy Factory** where we will have a guided tour and time to shop. Then we are off to **Bauman Farms** for some shopping. We will then travel to the quaint Bavarian town of Mt. Angel where we will have a hosted German lunch at the **Glockenspiel Restaurant**. This afternoon we will have a guided tour of the **Mount Angel Abbey**.

FRIDAY, APRIL 30 - Enjoy a hosted breakfast before we depart this beautiful resort. We will have a no host lunch stop in Eugene. Our accommodations for the night will be at the **Holiday Inn Express** in Medford. Tonight we will have a hosted dinner at the **Crackerbarrel**.

SATURDAY, MAY 1 - It is our final day. We will have a hosted breakfast at our hotel before we depart. We will make a stop at **Harry & David's** in Medford. Enjoy a hosted lunch at **C.R. Gibbs** in Redding. Approximate arrival time in the Bay Area will be 6 pm.
