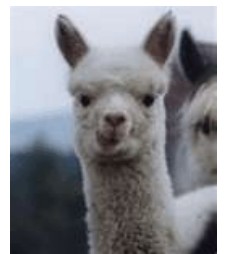

SUNDAY, JULY 21 - Come join us as we travel northward to take in the bounty of Southern Oregon. Enjoy a delicious hosted lunch at CR Gibbs. Our accommodations for the next five nights will be at the Holiday Inn Express in Medford, Oregon.

MONDAY, JULY 22 - A hot hosted breakfast awaits us this morning at our hotel. We begin our day at Wildlife Safari in Winston. The park gives us the chance to escape on a wild African Safari and get up close to Ostrich, Watusi cattle, Lions and Zebra. Venture through the homes of hippos and the land of the scimitar horned oryx. Our Safari journey will take us through Southern Africa where the Rhino and Giraffe rule. Carry on to interpretive wetlands, cleaning the local waters in reaffirmation of their commitment to the soil before venturing into the land of bears, bison and elk within the sprawling canyon forests of North America. Our first stop will be at the famous Harry & David's for a guided tour of their processing plant. Afterwards we will have time to browse in their store. We have a hosted lunch at Cracker Barrel before going to Dogs for a Better Life for a guided tour. Learn how rescued dogs from shelters are trained to act as the eyes and the ears of people who are hearing impaired.



THURSDAY, JULY 25 - Enjoy a hosted breakfast this morning before we go to a world class Alpaca Ranch, the Alpacas at Lone Ranch, where Alpacas are a love, a business and a way of life. Alpacas are considerably smaller than llamas, and unlike llamas, alpacas are not used as beasts of burden but are valued only for their fiber. Alpaca fiber is used for making knitted and woven items, much as sheep's wool is. These items include blankets, sweaters, hats, gloves, scarves, and a wide variety of textiles. . Our next stop takes in the Rogue Creamery and Lillie Belle chocolate factory. The Rogue Creamery is an artisan cheese company dedicated to the art of making the world's finest handmade cheese. They are known for their Bleu Cheese. Enjoy a hosted dinner at the Original Roadhouse before we travel to Ashland. Tonight we have reserved seating in the Elizabethan Theatre for the current performance that is being offer. Show announcement will be coming in January.

FRIDAY, JULY 26 - After a hosted breakfast at our hotel we travel back to California with our Oregon bounty. Our first stop will be at Lumberjack's for a hosted lunch. This afternoon we will stop at the Olive Pit where you can sample and purchase their olives and much more. Approximate arrival time home will be 6:00 p.m.
