**TUESDAY, APRIL 4** - Come join us as we travel north to The Evergreen State, **Washington**. Our first stop will be at the **CR Gibb's** for a hosted lunch. Our accommodations for the night will be at **Shilo Inn** in Bend, Oregon.

**WEDNESDAY, APRIL 5** - Today we continue north stopping at **Birchfield Manor** for a hosted lunch. Our accommodations for the next two nights will be at Ezian Inn in Leavenworth. Leavenworth is a quaint German town nestled in the mountains of central Washington State.

**THURSDAY, APRIL 6** - Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning. This morning we will travel to the town of Cashmere where we will have a tour of Liberty Orchards, producers of world famous Aplets & Cotlets. There will be time to browse in their store and partake of the samples before we return to Leavenworth. This 268 foot waterfall is one of Washington's most popular scenic attractions and is known internationally in the television series *Twin Peaks*. We will have a hosted lunch at the Salish Lodge which is at the top of the falls. Our accommodations for the next four nights will be at the **Embassy Suites** in Lynnwood. We have a hosted Manager's Reception at our hotel each evening.

**SATURDAY, APRIL 8** - Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning. Today we will travel to the quaint town of La Conner where you will have time to browse in the shops. We will board our **San Juan Island Cruise** boat for a cruise south through the beautiful Swinomish Channel, then north along Saratoga Passage to view the Deception Pass Bridge, one of the most photographed landmarks in Washington State. While onboard enjoy a hosted signature Cracked Crab lunch. Hosted Manager's Reception at our hotel this evening.

**SUNDAY, APRIL 9** - Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning. Today we will explore Mt. Rainier National Park. Ascending to 14,410 feet, Mount Rainier stands as an icon in the Washington landscape. An Active volcano, Mount Rainier is the most glaciation peak in the contiguous U.S.A., spawning five major rivers. Subalpine wildflower meadows ring the icy volcano while ancient forest cloaks Mount Rainier's lower slopes. Wildlife abounds in the park's ecosystems. We will have a hosted dinner at our hotel this evening.

**MONDAY, APRIL 10** - We will start our day with a hosted breakfast before traveling to the **Skagit Valley Tulip Festival**. This festival celebrates the beauty of the fields filled with blooming tulips of all colors and varieties. The growers at RoozenGaarde and Tulip Town offer display gardens worthy of that special photo and those unique souvenirs to commemorate your visit. We will make other stops along the way where you can find some special treats and gifts. We will have a hosted dinner at **Lombardi's** tonight.

**TUESDAY, APRIL 11** - Enjoy a hosted breakfast this morning before we depart for Long Beach. We will have a hosted lunch along the way. No visit to the Long Beach Peninsula would be complete without a visit to the **World Kite Museum** which is home to the Washington State International Kite Festival. Our accommodations for the night will be at the **Best Western Long Beach**.

**WEDNESDAY, APRIL 12** - After a hosted breakfast at our hotel we depart for our drive down the Oregon Coast. We will have a hosted lunch at the **Tillamook Cheese Factory**. Of course there will be Tillamook ice cream for dessert. Our accommodations for the night are on the beach at the **Chinook Winds Casino Hotel** in Lincoln City. The evening is free to try your hand at Lady Luck or take a walk on the beach.

**THURSDAY, APRIL 13** -Today we travel to Florence to the Sand Dune Frontier. We will board their Famous Big Purple Buggies for a ride on the **Oregon Sand Dunes**. We will have a interpretive scenic and fun ride over the rolling sand dunes. Afterwards we will have a hosted lunch at Mo's. This afternoon we will visit **Cranberry Sweets Candy** store where they make all kinds of sweet treats. You will have time to taste and shop. Our accommodations for the night will be at the **Old Mill Casino Hotel** in Coos Bay. Hosted dinner at our hotel this evening.

**FRIDAY, APRIL 14** - Hosted breakfast at our hotel before we will travel to Bandon to visit the **Washed Ashore Gallery**. Their mission is to build and exhibit aesthetically powerful art to educate a global audience about plastic pollution in the ocean and waterways and to spark positive change in consumer habits. We will stop at **Misty Meadows** where you will have time to shop for the best homemade jam and jelly on the Oregon Coast. We will have a hosted lunch in Gold Beach. Our accommodations for the night will be at the **Red Lion Inn** in Eureka. We will have a hosted dinner at the historic **Samoa Cookhouse** this evening

**SATURDAY, APRIL 15** - Our final day!! We will have a hosted breakfast at our hotel before we depart for home. We will stop along the **Avenue of the Giants** to get out and see them up close.
