- <u>TUESDAY, JUNE 4</u> Come join us as we travel north to the **Portland Rose Festival**. Our first stop will be at the **C.R. Gibbs** for a hosted lunch. Our accommodations for the night will be at **Seven Feathers Hotel Casino** in Canyonville, Oregon. The evening is free to try your hand at "Lady Luck".
- <u>WEDNESDAY, JUNE 5</u> Today we will visit the **Historic Carousel & Museum** for a guided tour. The Carousel has over 50 hand-carved animals on an antique mechanism and the museum has exhibits of historic carousel artifacts. We will have a hosted lunch before departing for Portland. This afternoon we will visit Multnomah Falls, Oregon's tallest waterfall.
- FRIDAY, JUNE 7 Hosted breakfast at our hotel before we go to Float Barn for a guided Behind-the-Scenes tour. We will see the finishing touches being done for tomorrow's parade. Afterwards we will go the International Rose Gardens where you will have time to walk around and visit Rose Festival gift shop for your souvenir shopping. We will have a hosted lunch at Salty's overlooking the Columbia River. This afternoon we will visit the End of the Oregon Trail Interpretive Center, where we will have a guided tour and learn about the history of the Oregon Trail and the pioneer families.
- SATURDAY, JUNE 8 Hosted breakfast at our hotel. The big event The Grand Floral Parade at Memorial Coliseum. Everyone will receive a souvenir program and rose pin. You will be delightfully captivated by the exciting spectacle of colorful exquisite floats, trained riders on their prancing mounts and professional marching bands playing in full-toned harmony. Afterwards we will board the Portland Spirit for a scenic cruise on the Willamettee River. Enjoy the views while enjoying a hosted lunch and listening to live piano music. Tonight we will see the performance of Clyde's at the Portland Center Stage. Two-time Pulitzer Prize-winner Lynn Nottage serves up this delicious comedy that centers laughs, redemption, and restorative justice. The formerly incarcerated kitchen staff at Clyde's are navigating their new lives on the outside and their tough-as-nails boss all while on a quest to create the perfect sandwich. The menu features loveable characters, big dreams, and a heartwarming story that's good to the last bite!
- <u>SUNDAY, JUNE 9</u> Hosted breakfast before we say goodbye to Portland and travel to the Oregon Coast. We will have a hosted lunch at the **Tillamook Cheese Factory**. Of course there will be Tillamook ice cream for dessert. This afternoon we have a guided tour at the **Tillamook Air Museum**. This museum features one of the country's top private collections of more than 40 World War II aircraft Our accommodations for the night are on the beach at the **Chinook Winds Casino Hotel** in Lincoln City. The evening is free to try your hand at Lady Luck or take a walk on the beach.
- <u>MONDAY, JUNE 10</u> -Today we travel to Florence to the Sand Dune Frontier. We will board their Famous Big Purple Buggies for a ride on the **Oregon Sand Dunes**. We will have a interpretive scenic and fun ride over the rolling sand dunes. This afternoon we will visit **Cranberry Sweets Candy** store where they make all kinds of sweet treats. You will have time to taste and shop. Our accommodations for the night will be at the **Old Mill Casino Hotel** in Coos Bay. Hosted dinner at our hotel this evening.



<u>TUESDAY, JUNE 11</u> - Hosted breakfast at our hotel before we will travel to Bandon to visit a cranberry bog to learn about process of growing cranberries.
