**SUNDAY, OCTOBER 13** - Come join us as we travel over the Sierra Nevada Mountains during the fall foliage season, to the eastern slopes and the town of Bishop. Our first stop will be for a hosted lunch in Carson City. Our accommodations for the next four nights will be at Holiday Inn Express in Bishop.

**MONDAY, OCTOBER 14** - Start your day with a hosted breakfast before boarding our motorcoach to go to the **Devils Postpile National Monument**. The formation is a rare geological sight and ranks as one of the world's finest examples of columnar basalt. We will have a hosted lunch in Mammoth Lakes. After lunch we will have a guided tour of the Mammoth Lakes area.

**TUESDAY, OCTOBER 15** - After you partake of the hosted continental breakfast, board our motorcoach to travel south to the **Museum of Western Film**. This museum is America's leading institution of western film history that pays tribute to the legendary heroes and heroines of America's West. We will have a **Guided tour of Alabama Hills** to see some of the movie site locations where Hollywood's biggest western stars performed. We will have a hosted picnic lunch along the way. This afternoon we will visit **Manzanar National Historic Site** for a guided tour. The Manzanar War Relocation Center was one of ten camps where the US government incarcerated Japanese immigrants ineligible for citizenship and Japanese American citizens during World War II. Tonight we will have a hosted dinner at the restaurant at Convict Lake.

**WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 16** - There will be a hosted breakfast at our hotel this morning before we begin exploring this beautiful area. This morning we will go to the **Ancient Bristlecone Pine Forest**. This forest is home to the oldest trees in the world, bristlecone pines. Some of these living trees exceed 4000 years of age and exhibit spectacular growth forms of twisted and beautifully colored wood. We will be at 10,000 feet for one to two hours. We will have a hosted lunch at Whiskey Creek before we go to the **Laws Railroad Museum** for a guided tour. We will step back in time at the historic Laws Railroad Museum featuring the original narrow-gauge railroad depot that served the once-active railroad community of Laws.

**THURSDAY, OCTOBER 17** - Start your day with a hosted breakfast before boarding our motorcoach to go to the **South Tufa Tower State Park**. We will have a hosted lunch at Nicely's before going to the **Mono Lake Visitor Center** where we will see a movie and have time to explore the exhibits there. Our accommodations for the night will be at the Carson Valley Inn in Minden.

**FRIDAY, OCTOBER 18** - Today we travel back over the Sierras. We will have a stop at **High Hill Apple Ranch** for shopping. Afterwards we will have a hosted lunch.
