<u>Sunday February 22<sup>nd</sup></u> - Come join us as we travel to the desert to explore **Death Valley National Park** and **Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area**. Our adventure will also include the **Mob Museum and Ethel M. Chocolate Factory** in Las Vegas. Our first stop will be at Pea Soup Andersen's for a hosted breakfast. Our accommodations for the night will be at the **Holiday Inn** in Barstow. Tonight we will enjoy a hosted dinner.

<u>Monday February 23<sup>rd</sup></u> - Start your day with a hosted breakfast before we travel to Death Valley. Our first stop will be at the Oasis for a hosted lunch. Afterwards we will visit the **Borax Museum** for a self-guided tour. The museum is the oldest structure in Death Valley and contains many artifacts from the mining period, an extensive mineral collection, and numerous outdoor exhibits located on the museum grounds. Our accommodations for the next two nights will be at **The Oasis at Death Valley Resort.**(B)(L)

<u>Tuesday February 24<sup>th</sup></u> - This morning you will enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel. Today we will explore Death Valley National Park. We will see the great **Sand Dunes**, the interesting displays at **Borax Mills**, the **Devil's Golf Course** and **Badwater**. We will enjoy a hosted lunch during the way. This evening enjoy a hosted dinner.

Wednesday February 25<sup>th</sup> - This morning you will enjoy a hosted breakfast before we depart Death Valley for Las Vegas. Our first stop will be at Golden Corral for a hosted lunch. This afternoon we will visit the Mob Museum which opened on February 14, 2012. The Mob Museum is dedicated to featuring the artifacts, stories, and history of organized crime in the United States, as well as the actions and initiatives by law enforcement to prevent such crimes. The museum is housed in the former Las Vegas Post Office and Courthouse, which was built in 1933 and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Our accommodations for the next two nights will be at the world famous Flamingo Las Vegas.

<u>Thursday February 26<sup>th</sup></u> - Today we will visit **Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area**. It's known for geological features such as towering red sandstone peaks and the Keystone Thrust Fault, as well as Native American petroglyphs. We will start our day at the visitor center before seeing the panoramic viewing spots along the scenic drive. This afternoon we will visit **Ethel M. Chocolates Factory**, which features house-made chocolates from recipes that date back to 1910. Ethel M. takes pride in making and processing everything in-house, including grinding their own nuts and making treats without preservatives. You will also have time to stroll through their 3-acre cactus garden and explore one of the most prolific botanical collections of its kind, featuring over 300 different species of plants. Tonight you will have the evening free to enjoy on your own.

Friday February 27<sup>th</sup> - Today we start back towards home, and will have a no-host lunch en route to Bakersfield. Our accommodations for the night are at the **Double Tree Hotel** in Bakersfield. Tonight we will enjoy a hosted dinner at **Chalet Basque Restaurant** while being entertained by **Jerry Hall and Trick Shot**. Jerry Hall and Trick Shot is one of the most popular country western Bands in the San Joaquin Valley The band came together more than 30 years ago and has shared the stage with numerous celebrities, both country and western.

<u>Saturday February 28<sup>th</sup></u> - Enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel before we travel home. Our first stop will be at **Bravo Farms**, which is known for its famous treehouse and quirky charm. Bravo Farms is a family-friendly destination offering artisan cheese, fresh fudge, and a variety of novelty gifts. Afterwards we'll travel to the **Hilmar Cheese Factory** for a guided tour and hosted lunch. Approximate arrival time in the Bay Area will be 5:00 p.m. (B)(L)
