This afternoon we will have time at the **Los Angeles Farmer's Market**, a favorite destination among locals and tourists since 1934. Here you will enjoy lunch and shopping on your own. (B)

Presidential Library. The library is the presidential library and burial site of Ronald Reagan, the 40th President of the United States, and his wife Nancy Reagan. The library encompasses more than 100 acres of collections and beautiful gardens in a dramatic hilltop setting overlooking the ocean and Southern California. Learn about the 40th President of the United States through the Museum and Library's many permanent and visiting exhibitions. Here you will visit the museum on your own before we enjoy a hosted lunch.

Friday May 8th
