Bragg, the Skunk Train, Mendocino Coast Botanical Gardens, Drive Through Tree, Avenue Of The Giants, Humboldt Bay Harbor Cruise, Humboldt Bay Maritime Museum, Great Cat's World Park, Oregon Shakespeare Festival Production Tour, and the Oregon Shakespeare Festival.** Our first stop will be at the **Charles Schultz Museum** for a self-guided tour and hosted lunch. Our accommodations for the next two nights will be at the Best Western Vista Manor Lodge. (L)

**Friday June 12<sup>th</sup>** - Start your day with a hosted breakfast before we depart for the **World-Famous Skunk Train.** Here you will enjoy a 7 mile train ride with a picnic lunch along the way. This afternoon we will visit the **Mendocino Coast Botanical Gardens** for a self-guided tour. This evening you will enjoy a hosted dinner. (B) (L) (D)

**Saturday June 13<sup>th</sup>** - After your hosted breakfast we will depart towards Eureka. Our first stop will be at the **Drive-Thru Tree Park** where you will have time to enjoy this hidden paradise along the **Avenue of the Giants.** This afternoon you will enjoy a hosted lunch as continued to travel north. This afternoon we will visit the **Humboldt Bay Maritime Museum** where you will have time to view exhibits that include artifacts related to ships and lighthouses. This evening we will enjoy a hosted dinner at the **Bay Front Restaurant.** (B) (D)

**Monday June 15<sup>th</sup>** - Start your day with breakfast before we depart for Oregon. Our drive along this scenic coastline will take us to Cave Junction where you will enjoy a hosted lunch at **Taylor's Sausage Country Store.** The afternoon will take us to the **Great Cats World Park.** Here you will be able to talk with their keeper, witness exciting demonstrations, and learn about the collection of exotic cats, all while getting an up close and personal look. Our accommodations for the next three nights will be at the **Historic Ashland Springs Hotel** in Ashland, Oregon. Built in 1925 and lovingly restored, this downtown landmark is a haven of taste reminiscent of small European hotels. (B) (L)



**Tuesday June 16<sup>th</sup>** - Enjoy an amazing breakfast at your leisure this morning. The day will be yours to enjoy Ashland on your own. You can enjoy world-class theater at the Oregon Shakespeare Festival, relax in the beautiful Lithia Park, explore fine art at the Schneider Museum of Art, or visit the many shops and restaurants Ashland has to offer. **Wednesday June 17<sup>th</sup>** - This morning before we depart enjoy a hosted breakfast at our hotel. The day will take us to the **Oregon Shakespeare Festival Production Shop**. The production departments are where the magic happens, from crafting breathtaking sets to weaving together the perfect costumes. Here you will enjoy a guided tour. This evening we will have a hosted dinner at our hotel before we see an evening performance at the Oregon Shakespeare Festival. (B) (D)

**Thursday June 18<sup>th</sup>** - After a hosted continental breakfast at our hotel we travel back to California with our Oregon bounty. Our first stop will be at **CR Gibbs** for a delicious hosted lunch. This afternoon we will stop at the **Olive Pit** where you can sample and purchase their olives and much more.
