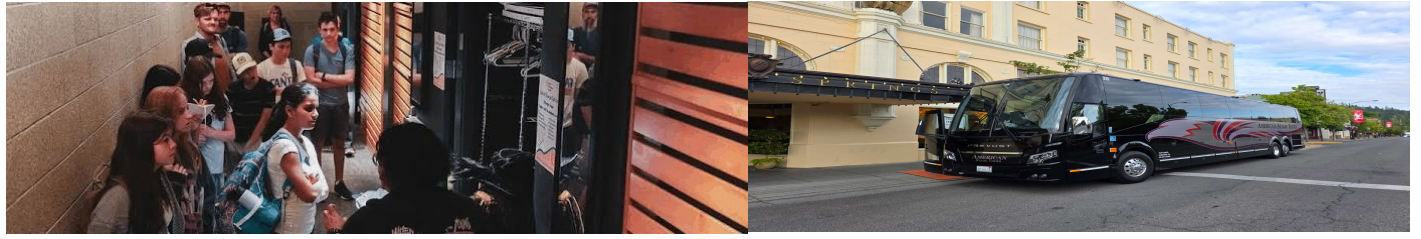
**Monday July 12<sup>th</sup>** - Begin your day with a hosted breakfast at our hotel before we travel east into the breathtaking landscapes of Southern Oregon.
